

Lilac Bath Set

Herrschners[®]

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SKILL LEVEL:

Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE:

Pouf: 4" (10.2cm)

Mitt: 7 x 8½" (17.8 x 21.6cm)

Scrubber: 7 x 29" (17.8 x 74cm)

MATERIALS:

- Willow Yarns™ Cairo Cotton
- -Lavish Lilac or color of choice
(10.6 oz/300g)



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



GAUGE:

16 dc and 7 rows = 4" (10.2cm) over mitt/scrubber

Gauge for pouf is not essential.

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (**ch**), slip stitch (**sl st**), single crochet (**sc**), half double crochet (**hdc**), double crochet (**dc**)

bead st (bead stitch): Dc in indicated st, working around post of dc just made, (yo, pull up a lp) 4 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

dc2tog (double crochet 2 together):

(Yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through 2 lps) twice, yo, pull through all lps on hook. (1 st decreased)

DIRECTIONS:

Bath Pouf:

Ch 5, sl st in first ch to form a ring, ch 35, sl st in first ch to form hanging lp.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 25 sc in ch-5 ring, sl st in first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, 5 dc in each sc around, sl st in first dc to join. (125 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, 5 dc in each dc around, sl st in first dc to join. (625 dc)

Fasten off.

Bath Mitt:

Front:

Ch 22.

Row 1: Dc in second ch from hook and each ch across (sk chs do not count as st). Turn. (20 dc)

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Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st here and throughout), dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (9 bead sts)

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in each dc and bead st across. Turn. (20 dc)

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in each dc and bead st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog. Turn. (18 dc)

Row 6: Ch 2, dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (8 bead sts)

Row 7: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in each dc and bead st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog. Turn. (16 dc)

Row 8: Ch 2, dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (7 bead sts)

Row 9: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in each dc and bead st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog. Turn. (14 dc)

Row 10: Ch 2, dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (6 bead sts)

Row 11: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in each dc and bead st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog. Turn. (12 dc)

Row 12: Ch 2, dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (5 bead sts)

Row 13: Ch 2, dc in each dc and bead st across. Turn. (12 dc)

Edging:

Sc in 12 dc across top, (no need to work extra sts in top edge corner sts), turn to work across the side, sc to last st on side, (sc, ch 1, sc) in bottom corner st, sc across next 20 sts, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next bottom corner st, turn to work across the next side, sc along the side of Mitt, sl st to first sc to join. Fasten off.

For next rnd of edging, join yarn with sl st to any bottom corner st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in same st as join, work sc around entire Mitt to next bottom corner st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in bottom corner st, sc across last edge of mitt and sl st to first sc to join. Fasten off.

Back

Ch 21.

Row 1: Dc in second ch from hook and each ch across (sk chs do not count as st). Turn. (20 dc)

Rows 2-4: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in next 16 dc, dc2tog. Turn. (18 dc)

Row 6: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Turn.

Row 7: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in next 14 dc, dc2tog. Turn. (16 dc)

Row 8: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in next 12 dc, dc2tog. Turn. (14 dc)

Row 10: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Turn.

Row 11: Ch 2, dc2tog, dc in next 10 dc, dc2tog. Turn. (12 dc)

Rows 12-13: Ch 2, dc in each st across. Turn.

Edging:

Hdc across 12 dc, (no need to work extra sts in top edge corner sts), turn to work across the side, sc at the end of row to next corner, (sc, ch 1, sc)

in bottom corner st, sc across next 20 sts, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next bottom corner st, turn to work across the next side, sc along next side of Mitt, sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Joining:

Holding Front and Back of Mitt with WS tog, working through both pieces, sl st to any corner st, work sc in each st up the side and around to opposite side, leaving bottom edge unworked. Fasten off at opposite side of bottom corner st.

Shower Scrubber:

Ch 21.

Row 1: Dc in second ch from hook and each ch across (sk chs do not count as st). Turn. (20 dc)

Row 2: Ch 2, dc in first dc, sk next dc, *bead st in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn. (9 bean sts)

Row 3: Ch 2, dc in each dc and bead st across. Turn. (20 dc)

Rep Rows 2-3 twenty-two times. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each dc across, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, sc evenly spaced down the side, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next corner st, sc across the bottom, (sc, ch 1, sc) in corner st, sc evenly up opposite side, (sc, ch 1) in corner st, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 30 (beg of handle), sk all sc along top edge, sl st to corner on opposite end, sc in each sc down side, ch 30 (start of opposite handle), sk all sc along bottom edge, sl st to opposite side, sc in each sc up opposite side, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in next 30 chs, sc in each st along next side, sc in next 30 chs, sc in each st along the next side, sl st to first sc to join.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
