

Lucky Clover Dishcloths

Herrschners

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SKILL LEVEL:
Easy

FINISHED SIZE:
7½" (19.1cm) dia



MATERIALS:

- Herrschners® Cottage Cotton
 - Silver Sage (3.5 oz/100g): Color A
 - Hilltop (3.5 oz/100g): Color B

YOU WILL NEED:

- Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Locking stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

20 sc and 9 rows = 4" (10.2cm)
Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc)
sc3tog (single crochet 3 together): (Insert hook in indicated st, yo, pull lp through) 3 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook. (2 sts decreased)

hdc2tog (half double crochet 2 together): Yo, (insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through) twice, yo, pull through all lps on hook. (1 st decreased)

fsc (foundation single crochet): Ch 2, insert hook in second ch from hook, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through 1 lp, (ch made), yo, pull through 2 lps on hook (sc made), *insert hook in ch made, yo, pull lp through, yo, pull through

1 lp, (ch made), yo, pull through 2 lps on hook, (sc made); rep from * as indicated in pat.

DIRECTIONS:

(Make 1 with Color A for first color and Color B for second color. Make 1 with Color B for first color and Color A for second color).

First Leaf:

With first color, ch 4, sl st to first ch to form a ring.

Row 1 (RS): 3 sc in center of circle, turn, place marker to track the RS.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, turn. (5 sc)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) twice, turn. (7 sc)

Row 4: Ch 1, sc across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 2 st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) twice, sc in last st, turn. (9 sts)

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 2 st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 2 sts, turn. (11 sts)

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 3 st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 3 sts turn. (13 sts)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc across, turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 3 sts, turn. (15 sts)

Row 10: Ch 1, sc across, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last 4 sts, turn. (17 sts)

Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts) twice, turn. (19 sts)

Row 13: Ch 1, sc across, turn.

Row 14: Ch 1, hdc2tog in first 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, working in the st 2 rows down, sl st in next st, hdc in next

3 sts, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog in last 2 sts. Fasten off. (17 sts)

Next Leaf:

With WS facing, join first color with sl st in beg ch-4 sp.

Rep Rows 1-14.

Note: Use a locking st marker to hold leaves tog until sewing tog, if desired.

Rep Next Leaf twice more.

Joining:

*Overlap the second leaf over the First Leaf approx ¼", with first color, work a running st from ch-4 sp to top of Row 13, do not join on Rnd 14; rep from * for last 2 leaves. Rep once more to join the First Leaf with the last leaf.

Border:

Join second color with sl st to the first st to the right of any sl st from Rnd 14.

Ch 1, sc in same st, *sl st in the sl st, (sc, ch 1) to hdc2tog, sc in last st, ch 1, sc3tog (on the side of Row 14, in the join bet leaves, and side of Row 14 of next leaf, ch 1, sc in next st, (ch 1, sc) to sl st; rep from * to first sc, ch 1, sl st to first sc to join.

Stem Hanger:

Work 12 fsc, sl st on WS of last sc to join.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.

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
