

Cottontail Carryall—Set of 2

SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

6 x 9" (15.2 x 22.9cm)

MATERIALS:

- Herrschners® My Ami Yarn
- White (3.5 oz/100g): Color A
- Rosy (3.5 oz/100g): Color B
- Ballerina (1.75 oz/50g): Color C
- Black (1.75 oz/50g): Color D



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

16 sc and 18 rows = 4" (10.2cm)
Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using

the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc), treble crochet (tr)
sc2tog (single crochet 2 together): (Insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through) twice, yo, pull through all lps on hook. (1 st decreased)
sc3tog (single crochet 3 together): (Insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through) 3 times, yo, pull through all lps on hook. (2 sts decreased)
magic circle: Form a circle with the end not attached to the ball on the left side of the circle. Insert hook in center of circle and yo from yarn that is attached to the ball, pull through center and ch 1. Follow instructions in pat. When you

have finished completing the number of sts that the pat calls for, then slowly pull the end not attached to the ball to close the circle.

surface crochet: With RS facing, and working yarn on the WS, insert hook in designated st, pull sl st through, working bet sts, *insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through and through lp on hook; rep from * as indicated in pat.

DIRECTIONS:

(Make 1 each with Color A and Color B).

Make a magic circle.

Foundation Rnd: Ch 1, 6 sc in center of circle, place marker in first sc, do not join, work in continuous rnds, moving the marker up each rnd, unless otherwise instructed, pull to close circle. (6 sc)

Rnd 1: 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

Rnd 2: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * around. (18 sc)

Rnd 3: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * around. (24 sc)

Rnd 4: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * around. (30 sc)

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Page 2 of 2

Rnd 5: Sc in next 2 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sc. (36 sc)

Rnd 6: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * around. (42 sc)

Rnd 7: Sc in next 3 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * to last 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc. (48 sc)

Rnd 8: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc; rep from * around. (54 sc)

Rnd 9: Sc in next 4 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc. (60 sc)

Rnd 10: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc; rep from * around. (66 sc)

Rnd 11: Sc in next 5 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc; rep from * to last 5 sc, sc in last 5 sc, sl st to first sc to join. (72 sc)

Rnd 12: Ch 1, working in back lps only, sc in same st and in each sc around; join to first sc with sl st.

Rnds 13-34: Ch 1, working in both lps, sc in same st and in each st around; join to first sc with sl st.

Rnd 35: *Sc2tog, sc in next 10 sts; rep from * around, sl st to first sc to join. Do not fasten off.

Note: Place markers in the first and 34th sts. (66 sc)

With a separate strand of matching color, with RS facing, working bet Rnds 11 and 12, work surface crochet sts around. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Ears:

Continue working from Rnd 35.

Row 1: Sc in same st as joining, ch 2, sk 2 sc, *sc in next sc, ch 2, sk 2 sc; rep from * around, moving markers up. Join to first sc with sl st. (22 ch-2 sps)

First Ear:

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in ch-2 sp; rep from * to marker, ch 1, turn. (33 sc)

Row 3: Sc2tog twice, sc to last 4 sts, sc2tog twice, ch 1, turn. (29 sc)

Row 4: Sc in each sc across; join to first sc with a sl st, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: Rep Row 3. (25 sc)

Row 6: Rep Row 4.

Row 7: Sc2tog, sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog, ch 1, turn. (23 sc)

Row 8: Rep Row 4.

Row 9: Rep Row 7. (21 sc)

Row 10: Rep Row 4.

Row 11: Rep Row 3. (17 sc)

Row 12: Rep Row 4.

Row 13: Rep Row 7. (15 sc)

Row 14: Rep Row 4.

Row 15: Rep Row 7. (13 sc)

Row 16: Rep Row 4.

Row 17: Rep Row 3. (9 sc)

Row 18: Rep Row 4.

Row 19: Rep Row 3. (5 sc)

Row 20: Rep Row 7. (3 sc)

Row 21: Sc3tog. Fasten off.

Second Ear:

With RS facing, join matching color in the 34th (marked) st.

Rep Row 2-21 from First Ear. Do not fasten off.

Edging:

Work 1 row of sc around the top, working 1 sc in the side of each row, 3 sc in the tip of each ear. Fasten off.

Drawstrings:

(Make 2 each with Color A and Color B).

Ch 121.

Sl st in second ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off. (120 sts)

Nose (make 2):

With Color C, make a magic circle.

Ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc) 3 times in center of circle; join to first sc with sl st. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Whiskers (make 4):

With Color A, ch 9.

Sl st in second ch from hook and in next 7 chs, *ch 9, sl st in second ch from hook and in next 7 chs; rep from * once more. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Eyes (make 4):

With Color D, make a magic circle.

Ch 1, work 6 sc in center of circle, pull tail to close circle. Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Finishing:

Using image as a guide, working in the ch-2 sps from Rnd 1 of Ear, weave 1 Drawstring from center front to center back, tie ends tog. Rep with the second Drawstring on opposite side of carryall. With tail, sew a Nose to center front of carryall. With tail, sew 1 Whisker on each side of the Nose. With tails, sew 1 Eye on each side of the Nose. With Color C, embroider a mouth with straight stitches. Weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
