SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

17 x 10" (43 x 25cm),
not including handles

MATERIALS:

• Soho® Playful Yarn
-Borealis (7 oz/200g)



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Locking stitch markers
- 19mm button
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc)
picot: Ch 2, sl st in sc just worked.

surface crochet: With RS facing and working yarn in the WS, insert hook in designated sp, make a sl st and place on hook, pull lp through, *insert hook in next sp, yo, pull lp through and through lp on hook; rep from * as indicated in pat.

DIRECTIONS:

Sides (make 2):

Ch 4.

Row 1 (RS): 2 sc in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch, ch 1, turn. (5 sc)

Row 2: Sc in each st across, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: 2 sc in each st across, ch 1, turn. (10 sc)

Row 4: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (15 sc)

Rows 6-7: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 8: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (20 sc)

Rows 9-10: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 11: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (25 sc)

Rows 12-13: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 14: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (30 sc)

Rows 15-16: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 17: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (35 sc)

Rows 18-19: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 20: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn (40 sc)

Rows 21-22: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 23: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (45 sc)

Rows 24-25: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 26: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (50 sc)

Rows 27-28: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 29: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (55 sc)

Rows 30-31: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 32: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (60 sc)

Rows 33-34: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 35: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (65 sc)

Rows 36-37: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 38: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (70 sc)

Rows 39-40: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 41: *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 13 sc; rep from * across, ch 1, turn. (75 sc)

Rows 42-43: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 44: (Sc, picot) in first st, *sc in next st, (sc, picot) in next st; rep from * across, sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Edging:

With RS facing, join yarn in first st of Row 1 ready to work along the end of rows.

Work 34 sc evenly spaced along the side. Fasten off. With RS facing, join yarn in first st of Row 42, work 34 sc along the side. Fasten off.

Spines:

Note: Pull through to color of choice to work the surface crochet sts or work colors as you come to them.

Using image as a guide, count 4 picots from either side, place marker in the next st, (count 5 picots from last marker, place marker in the next st) 6 times. Beg from Row 1, work surface crochet sts from Row 1 to the markers, working in sps every 2 rows, making sure that the lines are straight. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Base (make 2):

Ch 16.

Row 1: 2 sc in second ch from hook, sc in next 13 chs, 2 sc in last ch, ch 1, turn. (17 sc)

Row 2: 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in last sc, ch 1, turn. (19 sc)

Row 3: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 17 sc, 2 sc in last sc, ch 1, do not fasten off. (21 sc)

Edging:

Ch 1, 3 sc in corner, 3 sc along the side, 3 sc in next corner, sc in next 13 sts, 3 sc in corner, 3 sc along the side, 3 sc in corner, sc in next 19 sts; join to first sc with sl st. Fasten off. (50 sc)

Assembly:

Using image as a guide, sew the Base to bottom of the Side. Holding Sides with WS tog, join yarn in Row 44, sl st in each st along the side, sl st in the Base, sl st in each st along the next side, matching sts. Fasten off.

Handles (make 2):

Ch 92.

Row 1: Working in back bumps, dc in third ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 2, turn. (90 dc)

Row 2: Working in front lps only, dc in each st across, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Holding Row 1 and Row 3 with WS tog, working through both layers, sl st across, matching sts. Fasten off. (90 sl sts)

Button Lp:

Beg with a 4" tail, ch 25 tightly. Fasten off, leaving a 4" tail for sewing. With 1 tail, sew lp tog on 1 end, with rem tail, sew to inside of the center back. Attach button opposite on the front of bag, 6 rows down from top.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
