

Blue Burst Pot Holders

Herrschners

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SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

9 x 9" (22.9 x 22.9cm)

MATERIALS:

- Village Yarn™ Craft Cotton  **4** MEDIUM
- Seaside (4 oz/112g): Color A
- Blueberry (5 oz/142g): Color B

YOU WILL NEED:

- Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

After completing Rnd 2, work should measure approx 4" (10.2cm) at widest sides. Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), treble crochet (tr)

4trcl: *Yo twice, bring needle around the front post of the st to the back, yo and come back around the post of the st, (yo and pull through 2 lps on hook) twice; rep from * 3 more times, yo and pull through all lps on hook.

9trcl: *Yo twice, bring needle around the front post of the st to the back, yo and come back around the post of the st, (yo and pull through 2 lps on hook) twice; rep from *

8 more times, yo and pull through all lps on hook.

DIRECTIONS:

Note: Make 2 starting with Color A and 2 starting with Color B.

With Color A (B), ch 5; join to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Sc in ring, *ch 5, [yo twice, insert hook in ring (yo, pull through 2 lps) twice] 4 times, yo pull through all 5 lps on hook, ch 1, ch 5, sc in ring; rep from * 3 more times.

Rnd 2: Sc in first sc, *[(4 tr, ch 1) twice, 4 tr] in next ch-1 sp, place marker in the second ch-1 sp (do not place marker on rep), sc in next sc; rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc, fasten off.

Rnd 3: With Color B (A), sc in marked ch-1 sp, ch 5, *9trcl using next (4 tr, sc, 4 tr), ch 1 (to close top of cluster), ch 5, sc in ch-1 sp, ch 5, 4 trcl over the next 4 tr (corner st), ch 1 to close, ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 5; rep from * 3 more times. Join with sc to first sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in first sc, *(4 tr, ch 1, 4 tr) in next ch-1 sp (top of 9trcl), sc in sc, work [(4 tr, ch 1) twice, 4 tr] in next ch-1 sp (corner), place marker in the second ch-1 sp (do not place marker on rep) sc in next sc; rep from *

3 more times. Join with sc to first sc, fasten off.

Rnd 5: Join Color A (B) with sc in marked sp, *ch 5, [9trcl using (4 tr, sc, 4 tr), ch 1, ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 5] twice, work 4trcl in next 4 tr (corner), ch 1, ch 5, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * 3 more times. Join with sc in first sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in first sc, *[work (4 tr, ch 1, 4 tr) in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc] twice, work [(4 tr, ch 1) twice, 4 tr] in next ch-1 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * 3 more times. Join with sc to first sc, fasten off.

Assembly:

Holding 2 matching motifs WS tog, using the Color A on the Color B or the Color B on the Color A, sc in each st around, going through both motifs to join, sl st to first sc to join.

Hanging Loop:

With same color of yarn used for border, join with sc in any corner sc, ch 10; join with sl st to sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
