## MATERIALS:

- Village Yarn™ Craft Cotton
  - Blueberry (5 oz/142g): Color A
  - Lemon Ice (7.5 oz/213g): Color B
  - Honeysuckle (7.5 oz/213g): Color C
  - Cream (12.5 oz/355g): Color D



## YOU WILL NEED:

- Size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

## GAUGE:

Motif = 6 x 6" (15.2 x 15.2cm)  
Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), double crochet (dc)

## DIRECTIONS:

### Mitered Square (make 27):

With Color A, ch 6, sl st to form a ring.  
**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join. Fasten off.  
**Row 2 (RS):** Join Color B in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 throughout), 3 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch 3, turn.

Cut Color B; join Color C.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in beg ch-4 sp, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 4, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch 3, turn.

Cut Color C; join Color D.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in beg ch-4 sp, turn.

**Row 7:** Ch 4, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch 3, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, 2 dc in ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, 3 dc in beg ch-4 sp. Fasten off.

## Finishing:

Sew squares tog into a 3 square by 9 square grid, using the image and assembly diagram as a guide for the direction of each square.

## Edging:

Join Color A in any ch-2 corner sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, \*3 dc in each ch-sp to next corner\*\*, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner sp; rep from \* around, ending at \*\*, sl st in third ch of beg ch 3 to join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
