SKILL LEVEL:
Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE:
10 x 26¼" (25 x 67cm)

MATERIALS:

- Willow Yarns™ Meadow
- Cream (3.5 oz/100g): Color A
- Lady Slipper (1.75 oz/50g): Color B
- Papaya (3.5 oz/100g): Color C



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

18 hdc = 4" (10.2cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), half double crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc)

PATTERN NOTES:

- Ch 1 at beg of each rnd does not count as st.
- Working in the back bump of the hdc rnds forces the top two lps of the hdc to move to front of work. This creates a 'V' along the front of the work, giving it texture and dimension.

DIRECTIONS:

With Color A, ch 120, sl st to form ring, being sure not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, sl st to first hdc to join. (120 hdc)

Rnds 2-3: Ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnds 4-5: With Color B, ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnds 6- 7: With Color A, ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, working a normal hdc, hdc in each st around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnd 9: With Color C, ch 1, (sc, 2 dc) in first st, sk next 2 sts, *(sc, 2 dc) in next st, sk next 2 sts; rep from * around, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnds 10-11: Ch 1, (sc, 2 dc) in each sc around, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 12: With Color A, ch 1, hdc in each st around, sl st in first hdc to join.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnds 14-15: With Color B, ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnds 16-17: With Color A, ch 1, hdc in back bump of each hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, working a normal hdc, hdc in each st around, sl st to first hdc to join. Rep Rnds 9-18 twice more. Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
