

Wildflowers Shrug

Herrschners

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SKILL LEVEL:
Easy

FINISHED SIZE:
10 x 23" (25 x 58cm)

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MATERIALS:

- Lighthouse™ Wildflowers
-Bellflowers (10.5 oz/300g)



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size 6 (4mm) 20" circular needles or size to obtain gauge
- Size 6 (4mm) straight needles
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

23 sts and 32 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and needle. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the needle size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the needle size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Knit (k), purl (p)

k2tog (knit 2 together): K next 2 sts tog. (1 st decreased)

ssk (slip, slip, knit): Sl next 2 sts 1 at a time to right needle, insert left needle under both sts and k tog. (1 st decreased)

PATTERN NOTE:

- To make shrug smaller or larger, measure around upper body including arms, then work fewer or more rows in the shrug according to gauge.

DIRECTIONS:

Shrug:

Cast on 118 sts.

Row 1: K3, *p2, k3; rep from * across.

Row 2: P3, *k2, p3; rep from * across.

Rep Row 1-2 for approx 45".

Bind off loosely in pat.

Strap:

Cast on 31 sts.

Row 1 (RS): P5, (k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p3) twice, k2, yo, k1, yo, k2, p5, turn.

Row 2: K5, (p7, k3) twice, p7, k5, turn.

Row 3: P5, (k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, p3) twice, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, p5, turn.

Row 4: K5, (p9, k3) twice, p9, k5, turn.

Row 5: P5, (k4, yo, k1, yo, k4, p3) twice, k4, yo, k1, yo, k4, p5, turn.

Row 6: K5, (p11, k3) twice, p11, k5, turn.

Row 7: P5, (k5, yo, k1, yo, k5, p3) twice, k5, yo, k1, yo, k5, p5, turn.

Row 8: K5, (p13, k3) twice, p13, k5, turn.

Row 9: P5, (k6, yo, k1, yo, k6, p3) twice, k6, yo, k1, yo, k6, p5, turn.

Row 10: K5, (p15, k3) twice, p15, k5, turn.

Row 11: P5, (k1, ssk, k9, k2tog, k1, p3) twice, k1, ssk, k9, k2tog, k1, p5, turn.

Row 12: Rep Row 8, turn.

Row 13: P5, (k1, ssk, k7, k2tog, k1, p3) twice, k1, ssk, k7, k2tog, k1, p5, turn.

Row 14: Rep Row 6.

Row 15: P5, (k1, ssk, k5, k2tog, k1, p3) twice, k1, ssk, k5, k2tog, k1, p5, turn.

Row 16: Rep Row 4.

Row 17: P5, (k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, p3) twice, k1, ssk, k3, k2tog, k1, p5, turn.

Row 18: Rep Row 2.

Row 19: P5, (k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, p3) twice, k1, ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, p5, turn.

Row 20: K5, (p5, k3) twice, p5, k5, turn.

Rep Rows 1-20 twice more.

Rep Rows 1-19.

Bind off in pat.

Finishing:

Holding WS of shrug tog, line up ends and sew tog. Turn RS out. With RS facing, wrap strap around shrug over seam line, line up strap ends sew tog. Turn the seam to inside of shrug. To keep strap from moving, you can tack the inside of the shrug to the strap.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
