SKILL LEVEL:

Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE:

13 x 7" (33 x 17.8cm)

MATERIALS:

- Willow Yarns™
Freesia Cotton
-Ruby Mist (7 oz/200g)



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size F-5 (3.75mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Size E-4 (3.5mm) hook
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

24 sts and 8 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in pat with size F-5 hook

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc), treble crochet (tr)

cl (cluster): (Yo, insert hook in indicated st or sp, yo and draw up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook.

sc3tog (single crochet 3 together): (Draw up a lp in the next st) 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook.

DIRECTIONS:

With size F-5 hook, ch 23.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in bottom bump of second ch from hook and each ch across, turn. (22 sc)

Rows 2-4: Ch 2, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as a dc), 3 dc in each sc across, turn. (67 dc)

Row 6: Ch 4, 2 dc in fourth ch from hook, ch 3, 2 dc in top of dc just made, sk 5 dc, sc in next dc, (ch 3, 2 dc in top of last sc, ch 3, 2 dc in top of dc just made, sk 5 dc, sc in next dc) across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 4 (counts as tr), 3 dc in third ch of each ch-3 sp across, tr in first ch of beg ch 4, turn.

Row 8: Ch 4, 2 dc in fourth ch from hook, ch 3, 2 dc in top of dc just made, sk 6 dc, sc bet skipped and next dc, (ch 3, 2 dc in top of last sc, ch 3, 2 dc in top of dc just made, sk 6 dc, sc bet skipped and next dc) across, last sc is bet skipped dc and beg ch 4, turn.

Rep last 2 rows 12 times.

Rep Row 7 once more.

Top Edging:

Row 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in top of tr, (ch 4, sk 6 dc, sc bet skipped and next dc) across, work last sc bet skipped dc and beg ch 4, turn. (11 ch-4 sps)

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2, 2 cl in each ch-4 sp across, turn. (22 cl)

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each cl across, turn. (22 sc)

Rows 4-5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 6: Change to size E-4 hook, ch 1, sc in each sc across, do not turn.

Handles Short (Long):

Rnd 1: With RS facing and size F-5 hook, ch 1, sc in edge of each of last 4 rows of Top Edging, 3 sc around post of cl, sc in last sc of next row, 4 sc around post of each of next 14 tr, sc in next ch, 3 sc in post of next dc, sc in edge of next 4 rows (72 sc along edge), ch 30 (75), working along opposite side of bag, sc in edge of first 4 rows, 3 sc around post of next dc, sc in next ch, 4 sc in next 14 ch-4 sps, sc in next st, 3 sc around post of next dc, sc in edge of next 4 rows, ch 30 (75), sl st in first sc to join. [144 sc, 2 ch-30 (75) sps]

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc3tog over next 3 sc 24 times, sc in each of next 30 (75) chs; rep from * once more, sl st in first sc to join. [108 (198) sc]

Rnds 3-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st in first sc to join.

Rnd 5: Change to size E-4 hook, ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st in first sc to join. Fasten off.

Finishing:

Weave in ends. Lightly block.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash. Dry flat.
