

Granny Grove Couch Caddy

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SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

28 x 12" (71 x 30cm)



MATERIALS:

- Herrschners® Supreme Worsted
 - Carnation (3.5 oz/100g): Color A
 - Salmon (3.5 oz/100g): Color B
 - Glacier (3.5 oz/100g): Color C
 - Honey (3.5 oz/100g): Color D
 - Cornflower (3.5 oz/100g): Color E
 - Cobalt (7 oz/200g): Color F

YOU WILL NEED:

- Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

Motif = 4½" (11.4cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure

it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc), double crochet (dc)
FPdc (Front Post double crochet): Yo, insert hook around post of st from front to back to front, yo, draw up a lp, (yo, pull through 2 lps) twice.
picot: ch 2, sl st in top of sc.

DIRECTIONS:

Motifs:

(Make 14 "A" Motifs with Color A for first color, Color C for second color, Color B for third color, and Color F for last color. Make 16 "B" Motifs with Color E for first color, Color B for second color, Color D for third color, and Color F for last color).

With first color, ch 4, sl st to first ch to form a ring.

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Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in center of ring, ch 3, (3 dc, ch 3) 3 times in center of ring, sl st to top of ch 3 to join. Fasten off. (3 dc on each side)

Rnd 2: Join second color in any ch-3 sp with a sl st, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-3 sp, ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from * around, sl st to top of ch 3 to join. Fasten off. (6 dc on each side)

Rnd 3: Join next color in any ch-3 sp with a sl st, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in same ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around, sl st to top of ch 3 to join. Fasten off. (9 dc on each side)

Rnd 4: Join fourth color in any ch-3 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, *(FPdc around next dc, dc in top of next dc, FPdc around next dc, dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, FPdc around next dc, dc in top of next dc, FPdc around next dc**, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from * to beg ch 3, ending last rep at **, sl st to top of ch 3 to join. (56 sts)

Joining:

Use image and Assembly Diagram as a guide. You will first stitch the vertical seams. Hold the bottom left and bottom center motifs with WS tog and work through the back lps only on both layers. Beg in the corner center st, use a tapestry needle and Color F to join 2 Motifs tog with a running stitch to the next corner st. Moving vertically up the Assembly Diagram, (hold the next 2 Motifs next to the previously joined Motifs and continue joining tog with a running stitch to the next corner) 6 more times to make 2 columns with 7 motifs each. Fasten off. Holding Motifs with WS tog, join the right column of motifs as established. Fasten off.

You will now sew across the rows. *Working from side to side, holding the Motifs with WS tog, work in back lps only and sew the rows tog with a running st from corner center st across to next corner center st. Fasten off. Rep from * five more times.

After completing the back of the couch caddy, work the front panel using the Motifs in the red outlined section,

joining Motifs to make a panel with 3 columns with 3 Motifs each.

Joining and Border:

Note: If necessary, alter sts before the corner (sc in 1 or 3 sts instead of 2) as needed. With back and the front RS facing, pin the front section on top of the back. With the long side on the top (the pocket opening will be to the left), join Color F in corner center st on the top right side with a sl st, ch 1, 3 sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, *[(sc, picot) in next st, sc in next 2 sts] to next corner center sc on opposite end, (3 sc in corner st; rep from * around, working through both layers where necessary to join the front panel to the back, sl st to first st to join.

If desired, with tapestry needle and Color F, sew a running stitch from the bottom to the top bet the first and second Motifs from the left side to separate for 2 pockets.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash.
