## SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

## FINISHED SIZE:

2½" (5.3cm) diameter

## MATERIALS:

- Herrschners® My Ami
  - Wheat (1.75 oz/50g): Color A
  - White (1.75 oz/50g): Color B
  - Walnut (1.75 oz/50g): Color C
- Herrschners® Plastic Canvas Yarn
  - Red (25 yds): Color D
  - Black (25 yds): Color E



## YOU WILL NEED:

- Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size to obtain gauge
- Size E-4 (3.5mm) crochet hook
- Locking stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

## GAUGE:

Rnds 1-5 = 2½" (10.2cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and hook. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the hook size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size that will give you the specified gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE:

Chain (ch), slip stitch (sl st), single crochet (sc)  
**magic circle:** Form a circle with the end not attached to the ball on the left side of the circle. Insert hook in center of circle and yo from yarn that is attached to the ball, pull through center and ch 1. Follow instructions in pat. When you have finished completing the number of sts that the pat calls for, then slowly pull the end not attached to the ball to close the circle.

## DIRECTIONS:

### Front/Back (make 12):

With G-6 hook and Color A, make a magic circle.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 1, work 6 sc in center of circle, do not join, place marker in first sc, work in continuous rnds, move marker up each rnd. (6 sc)

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

**Rnd 3:** (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around. (18 sc)

**Rnd 4:** (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around. (24 sc)

**Rnd 5:** (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around. Fasten off. (30 sc)

### Muzzle (make 6):

With G-6 hook and Color B, ch 2.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** 3 sc in second ch from hook, turn. (3 sc)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn. (5 sc)

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc, turn. (6 sc)

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc, turn. (8 sc)

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. (10 sc)

### Ears (make 12):

With E-4 hook and Color C, ch 5.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in second ch from hook, sc in next 2 chs, pulling through Color A in last sc, 2 sc in last ch, turn to work on opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 chs, sl st in sk ch. Fasten off Color C. (5 sts)

**Row 2:** Ch 2, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in same st as sl st, working in back lps, sc

in next 3 sc, sl st in next st to join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Antlers (make 12):

With E-4 hook and Color C, ch 8.

Sl st in second ch from and in next 2 chs, ch 2, sl st in second ch from hook, sl st in last 4 chs. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Hangers (make 6):

With G-6 hook, join Color A in the center st bet Antlers with a sl st.

Ch 25, sl st to same sl st. Fasten off.

### Assembly:

**Note:** If desired, do not weave in ends, there is a back added. Using image as a guide, holding the RS of the Front, with tail, sew the Muzzle on the lower Front with Row 1 centered over the middle. With Color D, embroider the nose with a French knot wrapped twice around the needle. With Color B, embroider the whites of the eyes with a French knot wrapped twice around the needle, with Color E, embroider the pupils with a French knot wrapped once around the needle, making sure to work through the bottom of the white French knot. With tails, sew the Ears and the Antlers to the top of the Head. Holding the Front and Back with WS tog, with Color A, sl st around working through all layers, encompassing all the yarn tails inside.

### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Spot clean.
