

Winterberry Place Mat & Coaster

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SKILL LEVEL:
Intermediate

FINISHED SIZE:
Place Mat: 16 x 14" (41 x 36cm)
Coaster: 7 x 5" (17.8 x 12.7cm)

MATERIALS:
• Village Yarn™ Craft Cotton
-Really Red (15 oz/426g)

YOU WILL NEED:
• Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size to
obtain gauge
• Yarn needle



STITCHES USED:

Chain (ch), single crochet (sc), half double
crochet (hdc), double crochet (dc), treble
crochet (tr)

GAUGE:

5 sts = 1" (2.5cm)

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be
proper size. As you begin your project, make
a sample swatch per the instructions using
the recommended yarn and hook. After you
complete the swatch, measure it, counting your
stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is
larger or smaller than specified, change the hook
size and make another swatch to get the correct
gauge. Keep trying until you find the hook size
that will give you the specified gauge.

DIRECTIONS:

Place Mat (make 2):

Ch 72.

Setup Row: Sc in second ch from hook and in
each ch across. Turn. (71 sc)

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in
next sc; rep from * across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next ch-1 sp,
*ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *
across, sc in last sc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in
next ch-1 sp; rep from * across, sc in last sc. Turn.
Rep Rows 2-3 for a total of 58 rows from beg. Do
not fasten off.

Place Mat Edging:

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), dc in same corner
st, *working 1 st in each ch-1 sp across, ch 1, hdc,
(ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, dc) twice; rep
from * 4 more times, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, sc) twice,
ch 1, hdc, ch 1, (dc, tr, dc) in last corner st.

Working down the side of the place mat, in
every other row, [*ch 1, sk 1 row, hdc in side
of next row, (ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1,
dc) twice; rep from * 3 times more, ch 1, hdc,
(ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, ch 1], work (dc, tr, dc) in
next corner st. Working in every other ch across
bottom, ***sk next ch, ch 1, hdc in next ch,
(ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, dc) twice; rep
from *** 4 more times, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, sc) twice,
ch 1, hdc, ch 1, (dc, tr, dc) in corner st. Rep from
[to] to next corner. Work dc in same st as beg
ch 4; join with sl st into top of beg ch 4.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, work 2 dc in same corner st, dc in
dc, dc in ch-1 sp, dc in hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp, *sc
each in next (sc, ch-1 sp, sc), hdc each in (ch-1 sp,
hdc), dc each in (ch-1 sp, dc, ch 1-sp, dc, ch-1 sp),
hdc each in (hdc, ch-1 sp)**; rep from * to **
4 more times, [sc in (sc, ch-1 sp, sc), hdc in
ch-1 sp, dc each in (hdc, ch-1 sp, dc), 3 dc in tr,
dc each in (dc, ch-1 sp, hdc), hdc in ch-1 sp]; rep
from * to ** 4 times. Rep from [to] once. Rep
from * to ** 5 times; rep from [to] once.
Rep from * to ** 5 times, sc each in (sc, ch-1 sp,
sc), hdc in ch-1 sp, dc each in (hdc, ch-1 sp, dc);
join with sl st into top of beg ch 3. Fasten off and
weave in ends.

Coaster (make 2):

Ch 24.

Setup Row: Sc in second ch from hook and in
each ch across, turn. (23 sc)

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, sk next sc, sc in
next sc; rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next ch-1 sp,
*ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *
across, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, sk next sc, *sc in
next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from * across,
sc in last sc, turn.

Row 4-11: Rep Rows 2-3.

Row 12: Rep Row 2. Do not fasten off at end of
row, turn.

Coaster Edging:

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as tr), dc in same corner st,
working 1 st in each ch-1 sp across, ch 1, hdc,
(ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, dc) twice, ch 1,
hdc, (ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, ch 1, (dc, tr, dc) in
last st in corner. Working down the side in every
other row, [ch 1, sk first row, dc, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1,
sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, ch 1, dc, ch 1], work (dc, tr,
dc) in corner st. Working in every other ch across
beg ch on the bottom, sk next ch, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1,
sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, (ch 1, dc) twice, ch 1, hdc,
(ch 1, sc) twice, ch 1, hdc, ch 1, (dc, tr, dc) in
corner st. Rep from [to] to next corner. Work
dc in same st as beg ch 4. Join with sl st into top
of beg ch 4.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, work 2 dc in same center corner st,
*dc each in (dc, ch-1 sp, hdc), hdc in ch-1 sp, sc
each in (sc, ch-1 sp, sc), hdc each in (ch-1 sp, hdc),
dc each in (ch-1 sp, dc, ch-1 sp, dc, ch-1 sp), hdc
each in (hdc, ch-1 sp), sc each in (sc, ch-1 sp, sc),
hdc in ch-1 sp, dc each in (hdc, ch-1 sp, dc), 3 dc
in center corner dc, dc each in (dc, ch-1 sp, dc),
hdc each in (ch-1 sp, hdc, ch-1 sp), sc each in (sc,
ch-1 sp, sc), hdc each in (ch-1 sp, hdc, ch-1 sp), dc
each in (dc, ch-1 sp, dc)**; 3 dc in center corner
dc; rep from * to ** once. Join with sl st into top
of beg ch 3. Fasten off and weave in ends.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash. Tumble dry on low until damp.
Shape and lay flat to complete drying.

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
