

Woven Trails Cowl

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SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

FINISHED SIZE:

Height: 12" (30cm)

Circumference: 24" (61cm)

MATERIALS:

- Nob Hill™ Yarns Lofty Tweed
-Amber Drift (7 oz/200g)



YOU WILL NEED:

- Size 8 (5mm) 24" circular needle or size to obtain gauge
- Size 8 (5mm) double pointed needles or size to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Safety pin (optional)

GAUGE:

16 sts and 22 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st

Exact gauge is essential for your project to be proper size. As you begin your project, make a sample swatch per the instructions using the recommended yarn and needle. After you complete the swatch, measure it, counting your stitches and rows carefully. If your swatch is larger or smaller than specified, change the needle size and make another swatch to get the correct gauge. Keep trying until you find the needle size that will give you the specified gauge.

STITCH GUIDE:

Knit (k)

k2tog: K 2 sts tog. (1 st decreased)

ssk (slip, slip, knit): Sl 1 st as if to k to the right needle, sl second st as if to k to the right needle, sl both sts back to the left needle and k tog through the back lps. (1 st decreased)

DIRECTIONS:

Cast on 98 sts using circular needle. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist work.

Rnds 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 (RS): *K2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 2 and All Even Rnds: K.

Rnds 11, 13, 15, 17, and 19: *K2, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from * around.

Rep Rows 1-20 four times or until cowl measures approx 12".

Bind off all sts. Weave in ends.

Knitted Cord:

Cast on 4 sts using double pointed needles.

Work knitted cord as follows: *k4, do not turn, sl sts to other end of dpn; rep from * until cord measures 36" or desired length. Bind off all sts. Weave in ends.

Finishing:

Thread knitted cord in and out of the eyelets at desired place around bottom of cowl. To thread cord in and out of eyelets easily, attach a safety pin to the end of the cord and use the pin to draw the cord through the eyelet holes.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Machine wash. Dry flat.
