FREE CROCHET PATTERN

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Sunday Market Bag

By Liz Salazar for Premier® Yarns

This Bag is worked from the Base upward in joined rounds. Join all rounds with a slip stitch unless otherwise noted.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 26¾"

Length: 11"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair® Worsted (52% Cotton, 48% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 207yds/190m)

- 2178-05 Cinnamon – 4 balls

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, 4 locking stitch markers

GAUGE

18 sc x 20 rnds = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chain, slip stitch, single, half double and double crochet stitches.
- Increasing and decreasing.
- Slip stitch joining.
- Working in 3rd loop of half double crochet.
- Sewing on buttons.
- Encasing elastic band in stitches.
- Working in rounds.
- Foundation single crochet.

Base

Rnd 1: Ch 33. Working in back bumps of chs, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch. Rotate piece and sc in next 31 unused loops on opposite side of the foundation ch, 2 sc in last unused loop, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 66 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st, sc in next 30 sts, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next 30 sts, 2 sc in each of last 2 sts, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 72 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 31 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next st; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 78 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st, *sc in next 32 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts*, 2 sc in next st; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 84 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 33 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 90 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in same st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 34 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * to * once, sc in last 3 sts, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 96 sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 35 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 102 sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 36 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * to * once, sc in last 4 sts, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 108 sc.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sts, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 37 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 7 sts; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 114 sc.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st, *sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 38 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts*, 2 sc in next st; rep from * to * once, join to first sc – 6 sc inc'd, 120 sc.

Note: Base should measure about 11" from end to end

Rnd 11: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc around, join to first sc – 120 blo sc.

Body

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), sk next sc, *dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from * around, join to beg dc – 60 dc, 60 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 1, *sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around, join to beg sc – 120 sc.

Rep Rnds 1-2 until Bag measures 10" from Rnd 11 of Base,

end having just worked a Rnd 2.

Handle Opening

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sts/sps, sc2tog; rep from * around, join to beg sc – 24 sc dec'd, 96 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc around, join to beg sc. Fasten off.
Mark the 4 Handle Openings as follows: With Bag lying flat, pm in back right-side corner where you want back right Handle Opening. Count 8 sts outward and pm in next st (back right Handle Opening marked). [Count 8 sts and pm in next st] twice (front right Handle Opening marked). Count 20 sts to the left and pm in next st. [Count 8 sts and pm in next st] 3 times (front and back left Handle Openings marked). If st markers are not aligned to desired Handle openings, readjust. You should have two 8-st right side Handle Openings with 8 sts between, and two 8-st left side Handle Openings with 8 sts between. You should have 20 sts between markers across the front and 20 sts between markers across the back.

Rejoin yarn in any of the 20 sts across back with a sl st.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, (sc in each sc to next marked st, ch-8, sk 8 sts, sc in next marked st) 4 times, sc in each rem st, join to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc and 8 sc in each ch-8 sp around, join to first sc.

Rnds 3-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join to first sc. Fasten off, weave in ends.

FINISHING

Handles (make 2)

Ch 91.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 90 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Insert end of first Handle into right front Handle Opening, fold Handle end approximately 1" upward and whipstitch to inside of Handle so that Handle is secured around Handle Opening. Whipstitch opposite end of same Handle to left front Handle Opening. Repeat these steps with other Handle and back Handle Openings

Weave in rem ends.
